Description	
Source	Recombinant Biotinylated Human M-CSF/CSF-1 Protein is expressed from HEK293 with His tag and Avi tag at the C-Terminus. It contains Glu33-Asn190.
Accession	P09603-1
Molecular Weight	The protein has a predicted MW of 21.3 kDa. Due to glycosylation, the protein migrates to 27-37 kDa based on Bis-Tris PAGE result.
Endotoxin	Less than 1EU per µg by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95% as determined by Bis-Tris PAGE > 95% as determined by HPLC

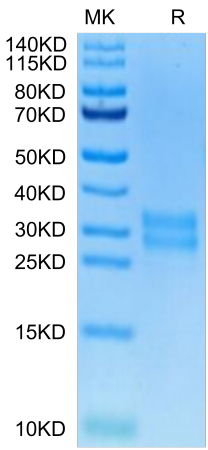
Formulation and Storage	
Formulation	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	Centrifuge the tube before opening. Reconstituting to a concentration more than 100 µg/ml is recommended. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water.
Storage	-20 to -80°C for 24 months as supplied from date of receipt. -80°C for 3 months after reconstitution. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background

CSF-1, also known as M-CSF, is a four alpha-helical-bundle cytokine that is the primary regulator of macrophage survival, proliferation and differentiation. CSF-1 is also essential for the survival and proliferation of osteoclast progenitors. CSF-1 is cytokine that plays an essential role in the regulation of survival, proliferation and differentiation of hematopoietic precursor cells, especially mononuclear phagocytes, such as macrophages and monocytes.

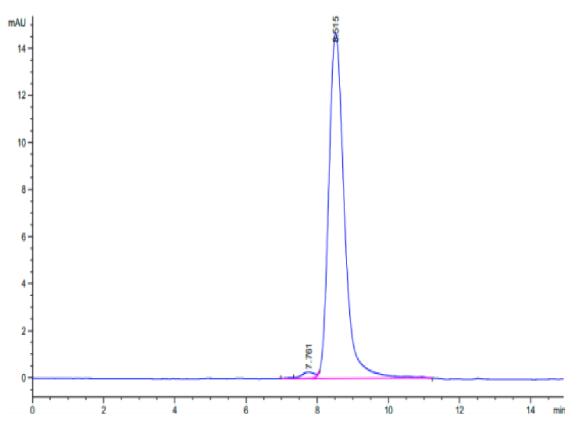

SEC-HPLC



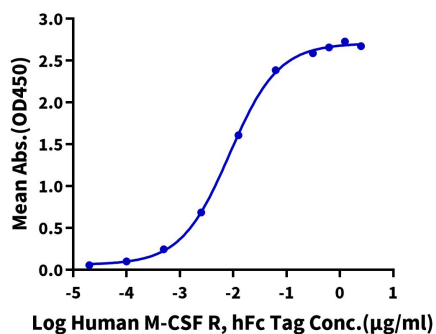
The purity of Biotinylated Human M-CSF is greater than 95% as determined by SEC-HPLC.
